- Each region will have link to their social media accounts where you can find out more about your region. Including Twitter and LinkedIn.







BIM Awareness:

Building Information Modelling

Who made the decision to build the site?

- As part of the gaols for the Eastern BIM Region the Steering Committee agreed that a website for BIM region Ireland would be the main goal for 2017.
- This was led by Co-Chair Cillan Kelly in collaboration with the BIM Regions, CitA, the BICP and "The B1M".
- Each region was contacted directly and asked to join the website as a central location for for sharing best practice resources with the wider BIM community.

Who is involved in running the site?

- Content is provided by industry experts and academia reviewed by the Group before sending to CitA to upload.
- The BIM Regions is responsible providing information on upcoming regional events.
- CitA are responsible for maintaining the site including updating content.

How often is it updated?

• The BIM Regions website is a live website and will be updated on an ongoing basis, Steering Committee members will discuss additions and updates at each group meeting



Why did the regions need a site?

• Earlier this year the Eastern BIM Region set out their goals and the website was the main gaol for 2017. We felt that there was a lot of discrepancy on BIM awareness across the country and we wanted to deliver a clear message to industry.

"The BIM Regions are a collaboration of specialist interest groups who will champion BIM in their respective specialist areas. Their purpose is to raise awareness of BIM, promoting a shared understanding of the value proposition and issues affecting the implementation of BIM in their respective areas of interests. The BIM Regions will seek to develop consistency of messaging in a clear and concise manner to support both new and existing professionals in their respective BIM journeys."

• After a review of the charter we felt that a central website would be the best way to meet deliver the BIM 4 Communities Charter which was signed by each BIM region when the forming each group.
