Article 5(4) of the Principal Regulations prescribes the "Building Control Management System" means the information technology-based system hosted by the Local Government Management Agency and developed to facilitate the electronic administration of building control matters by building control authorities as the preferred means of building control administration;"

2019 saw Dublin City Council(DCC) become the lead local authority for the National Building Control Office, which provides oversight, support and direction for the development, standardisation and implementation of Building Control (Building Control Acts 1990-2014) in the 31 Building Control Authorities.

2020 saw DCC become the lead local authority for the *National Market Surveillance Office*, which provides oversight, support and direction for the development, standardisation and implementation of Market Surveillance for Construction Products (<u>Construction Products Regulations EU 305/2011</u> (<u>S.I. No. 225 of 2013</u> and <u>S.I. 682 of 2020</u>)) in the 31 Market Surveillance Authorities under the regulations.

31 Building Control Authorities are designated Market Surveillance Authorities under the Regulations

Regulators for the:

Regulate design & construction of all buildings & works in Ireland, providing for the health and safety of people in or about buildings, access for all, the conservation of fuel and energy and promotion of good building practice i.e.

EU Energy Performance in Buildings Regulations S.I. 243 of 2012.


[Promotes the improvement of energy performance of buildings with the adoption of a methodology for calculating this. Provision of building energy certification for <u>all new</u> <u>buildings</u> and <u>existing buildings undergoing major renovation</u> and <u>building offered for sale</u> <u>or rent</u>. Public "Display of energy performance certificates" for buildings 500 m2. Independent <u>lists of accredited experts</u> for <u>energy performance certification</u> of buildings and <u>the inspection of heating systems and air-conditioning systems</u>. Enforcement through

penalties by Building Control Authorities, SEAI, NSAI]

Regulators for the: [The "<u>Construction Products Regulation</u>" EU 305 of 2011, prescribes BASIC REQUIREMENTS FOR CONSTRUCTION WORKS i.e.,

Construction works as a whole and in their separate parts must be fit for their intended use, considering in particular the health and safety of persons involved throughout the life cycle of the works. Subject to normal maintenance, construction works must satisfy these basic requirements for construction works for an economically reasonable working life."]

PURPOSE

- 12 Parts
- 48 Functional Requirements
- 9 Applications/Definitions

(1) Every works or building to which these Regulations apply shall be designed and constructed—

> (a) in accordance with the appropriate requirements set out in the Second Schedule, and


(b) in such a manner as to avoid the breaching of any other requirement of that Schedule.
(2) No works shall be carried out to a building which would cause a new or greater contravention in the building of any provision of these Regulations.

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





(IV) Preliminary Inspection Plan prepared by the Assigned Certifier,


-Inspections & Visibility on site most effective way to get compliance with the Building Regulations.

-Competent Builders, Designers, Building Control Officers – Training & CPD is a must. -Adequate Number of Trained Building Control Officers- must be available to inspect at the earliest possible stage in the construction process.




Legislation : Building Control Regulations (Administration) required to outline how compliance with the requirements of the Building Regulations (Design) is achieved

People: Competency, Resources & Meaningful Stakeholder Engagement-Do things right first time; time spent in planning & design critical construction allowed, welcome & necessary detection and prevention systems consideration of analysis method. **Construction: Process:** consideration of analysis methodology, concept, checking, site supervision, information provision, and other factors **Product:** specification of sources and performance requirements or checks on certification. Fit for the purpose, the intended use in the locations & conditions it is to be used for 50-60 years
